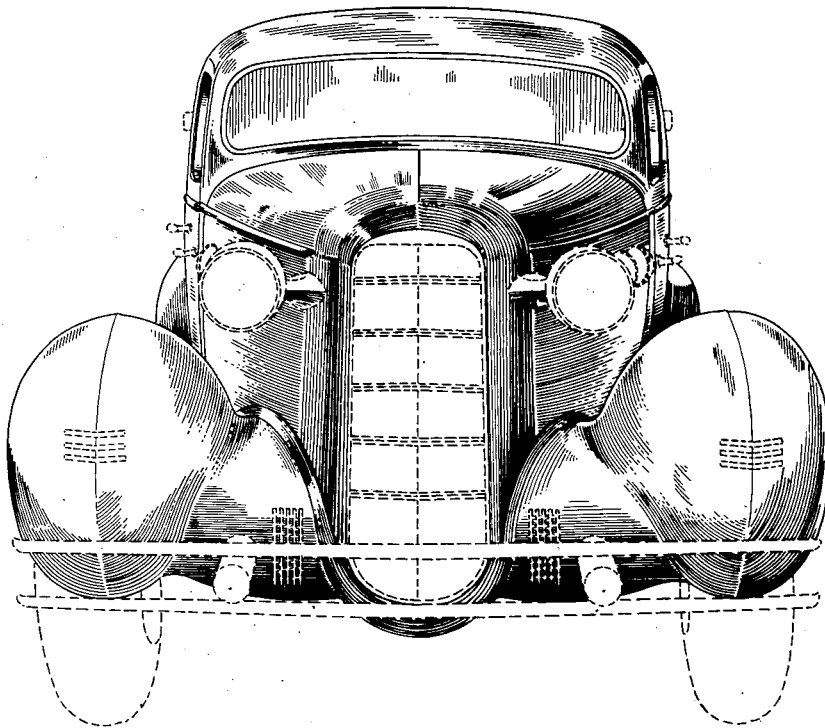

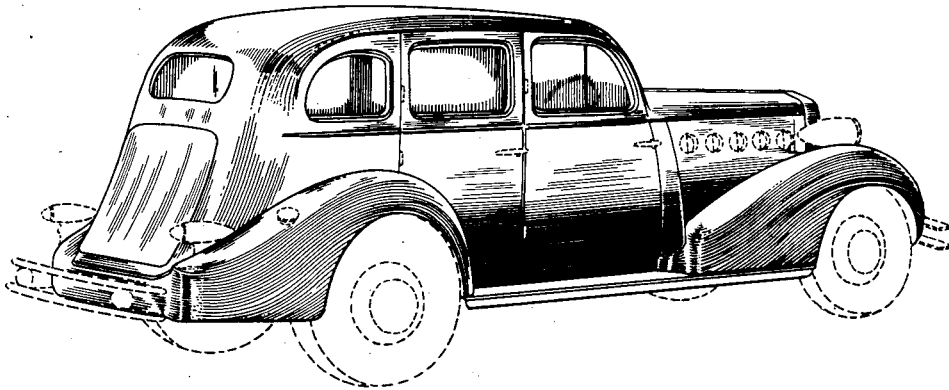

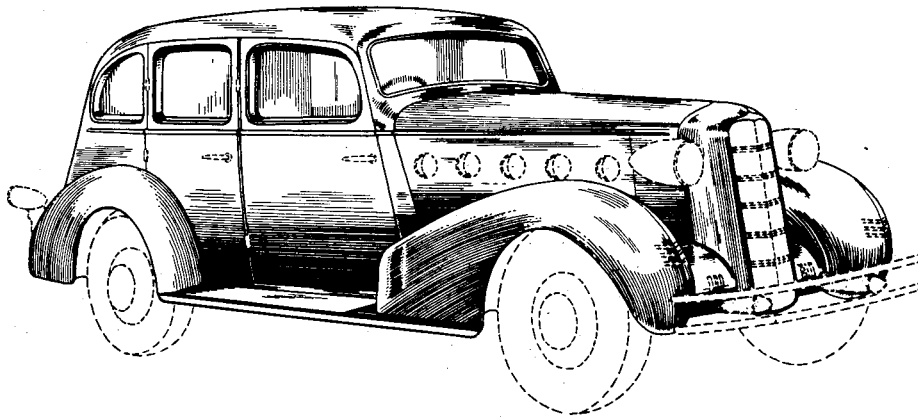

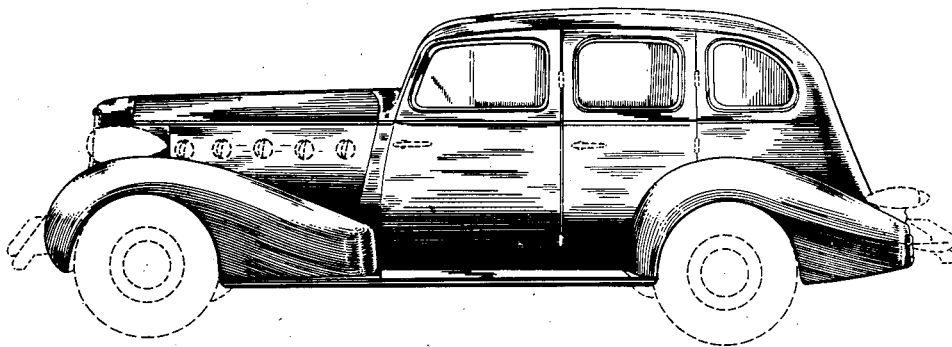

## DESIGN FOR AN AUTOMOBILE OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Harley J. Earl, Grosse Pointe Farms, Mich., assignor to General Motors Corporation, Detroit, Mich., a corporation of Delaware

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, HARLEY J. EARL, a citizen of the United States, residing at 139 Grosse Pointe Boulevard, Grosse Pointe Farms, in the county of Wayne and State of Michigan, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Automobile or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being made to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front view of an automobile, showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a front quarter perspective of the same;

Figure 3 is a rear quarter perspective of the same;

Figure 4 is a side elevation of the same.

The parts shown in the full lines form the dominant features of the design.

The ornamental design for an automobile or similar article substantially as shown and described.
